The purposes of this non-profit, non-stock corporation involve, among other things, 1) Promoting or encouraging the organization of municipal power districts, electric cooperatives and non-profit corporations, and municipally owned electric plants, 2) surveying electric power resources and facilities and making studies for their economical development, use and conservation, 3) making surveys for the coordination of water supply, navigation, flood control, soil conservation, public health, recreational and other uses.
