**Abstract:** Margaret Zettler was born in Milwaukee in 1908, the daughter of William Zettler a long-time bank employee. Taking Joan Falcy as a stage name, Margaret was a noted vaudeville/theater performer in the early 1920's in Milwaukee. She married Pepito Perez, himself an accomplished performer, in 1934. They moved to California and continued their theatrical careers. When they gave up that profession, they established a wildly successful and influential dance studio. Pepito died in 1975, and Margaret passed away on April 1, 2004.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of clippings, journals, correspondence, and other miscellaneous items related primarily to Margaret but also includes information pertaining to her mother and her aunt.
