Abstract: Richard "Dick" Lewis was a human resources manager, Realtor, and artist who worked with chalk and watercolors. He was born in 1942, graduated from Oconomowoc High School and Carroll College in Waukesha, and worked at International Harvester and J.W. Peters, Inc., for 33 years. He was a hobbyist painter whose work has been displayed at galleries in Milwaukee. Lewis died in 2014.

Scope and Content: This collection consists of three prints of watercolor paintings made by Richard Lewis, respectively depicting the entrance to the Milwaukee harbor and city skyline, the Milwaukee County War Memorial, and the Summerfest Grounds (Henry Maier Festival Park).
