Abstract: Historic Milwaukee, Inc. is a non-profit organization that raises awareness of and provides programming related to the architecture, built environment, and history of Milwaukee. It was founded in 1974 in the Walker's Point neighborhood and initially known as Historic Walker's Point. It adopted its current name in 1980 to reflect its broadened focus on the entire city. Historic Milwaukee's signature annual events are *Spaces & Traces*, which was first held in 1981, and *Doors Open Milwaukee*, which was first held in 2011.

Scope and Content: The collection consists primarily of programs from Historic Milwaukee, Inc's *Spaces & Traces* annual tour. Neighborhoods represented include Bay View, Brewers Hill and the Beerline, the East Side, Lincoln Avenue, the Lower East Side, Rufus King/Arlington Heights, Sherman Park, Story Hill, the Third Ward, Walker's Point, and Water Tower/North Point. Also included is the booklet "Prairie Influences: George Mann Niedecken & the Prairie Style in Milwaukee."
