Abstract: In 1967, Milwaukee Associates in Urban Ministries (M.A.U.M.) was formed to promote volunteerism in central city churches that provided social services. The group's mission was carried out by individuals participating in the national Volunteers in Service to America (VISTA) program. By the 1970s, MAUM was placing volunteers in projects with secular organizations, prompting a new membership structure and a new name, Milwaukee Associates in Urban Development (M.A.U.D.). In 1996, the group changed its name to the Nonprofit Center of Milwaukee, and it continues to promote the "organizational effectiveness of nonprofit groups dealing with the broad scope of urban issues."

Scope and Content: The collection consists of correspondence/memos, reports, programs, contracts, financial statements, and other ephemera.
