Abstract: The area that encompasses the present City of West Allis developed rapidly after Edward P. Allis began building a new factory for his company in 1900. The Village of West Allis was incorporated in 1902, named in honor of the Allis-Chalmers Company's founder. Four years later it was incorporated as a city and became one of the state's industrial centers.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of historical pamphlets and articles, annual reports, newspaper clippings, area studies/plans and a few issues of *West Allis Life*.
