**Abstract:** Terrence Herron graduated from Custer High School and the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee. He worked with several social service agencies before being elected to the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors in 1993, representing the 2<sup>nd</sup> District on Milwaukee's north side. He served on the Health & Human Needs Committee, the Judiciary Committee and the Youth Offenders Advisory Committee. He left the county board and won a seat as a Milwaukee alderman in 2000. He left Milwaukee to accept a position with Microsoft.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of meeting minutes, agendas, reports, resolutions, memoranda, reports, budget material and other ephemera that detail Herron's work with the county board and various committees, focusing particularly on juvenile issues.
