**Abstract:** Edward, Howard, and Raymond Landusky were a family of World War II veterans from Milwaukee. This collection was donated by Mequon Thiensville Historical Society in their name.

**Scope and Content:** Collection consists of one manuscript box which contains photographs of Edward, Howard, and Raymond Landusky in military uniforms, at military bases, and with unidentified family and friends. Other photographs include various childhood pictures of family and friends, holiday gatherings, and a vast collection of negatives. There is a funeral booklet and cards in relation to the same funeral and a first communion celebration. Outside of the box, there is a family scrapbook filled with family and friend pictures.
