Abstract: The Milwaukee Northern Railway Company, Milwaukee's third interurban company, began service between Milwaukee and Cedarburg in 1907. The company headquarters was in Cedarburg, and the Milwaukee station was on 5th Street between Wells and Kilbourn. The company also operated a streetcar line on their tracks through Milwaukee's north side, with a branch to Lindworm Park. The Milwaukee Electric Railway & Light Company (TMER&L) acquired Milwaukee Northern Railway in 1922 and was integrated into the TMER&L system.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of an indenture between the Milwaukee Northern Railway Company and the First Savings & Trust Company, a full-page advertisement re the Milwaukee Northern Railway Co. printed in *Deutscher Press-Club* (German text), and a 1918 letter regarding the operation of the company.
