Abstract: Milwaukee County Stadium was a multi-use stadium in Milwaukee that was owned by Milwaukee County. It was opened in 1953, closed in 2000, and demolished in 2001, effectively replaced by Miller Park (now American Family Field). County Stadium was primarily the home of Major League Baseball's Milwaukee Braves (1953-1965) and Milwaukee Brewers (1970-2000). It was also the Milwaukee (alternate) home venue of the National Football League's Green Bay Packers (1953-1994) and hosted numerous concerts and other events.

Scope and Content: The collection consists mainly of professional correspondence, meeting notes, project proposals, project reports, and contracts regarding the various issues covered in managing Milwaukee County Stadium. This includes the management of the stadium itself (such as parking, seating expansions, and electrical systems) and of its regular operations (security funding, behavior warning policy, and contracts), as well as certain contemporary events regarding the stadium (such as movements to rename it, efforts to install a dome, and the potential relocation of the Brewers).
